Dear Parent / Guardian,

Welcome to St. Pius X Faith Formation classes for the 2021-2022 school year!

This was received from the Archdiocese of Chicago: 2021-2022 Planning

Parishes can plan for resumption of full enrollment and in-class programming next year with full observance of all mitigation requirements in place for in-class activities in our Archdiocesan schools. As we progress through the spring and summer and receive any changes to public health guidelines, the Task Force will provide any necessary guidance.

The Archdiocese follows all guidelines set forth by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention and Illinois Department of Public Health. The classrooms and/ or parish hall will be thoroughly sanitized with a CDC approved sanitizer both before and after all class sessions.

Please note that at any time, if we are restricted from holding in-person classes due to COVID restrictions (increasing positivity rate, increase of cases, etc.) from the State of Illinois, or the Archdiocese of Chicago, the program would move to a remote/at-home catechesis model.

The St. Pius X Faith Formation program will be split into two sessions to allow for reduced capacity during class sessions.

The Faith Formation Classes for Grades Kindergarten through Grade 5 will meet on Saturday mornings, starting October 2, 2021 from 9:00am until 10:30am.

The Faith Formation Classes for Grades 6, 7 and 8 will meet on Tuesday evenings starting October 5, 2021 from 7:00pm until 8:30pm.

The Faith Formation Classes are for students in Kindergarten through Grade 8. High School students preparing for Confirmation will attend Faith Formation classes on Tuesday evenings. Kindergarten students must have reached their fifth birthday on/before September 1, 2021.

FAITH FORMATION tuition and fees for the 2021-2022 school year will be:  
\$140.00 for each student registered (Families Registered at St. Pius X)  
\$200.00 for each student of non-registered families of St. Pius X.

\$50.00 First Communion 2022 fee due March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022  
\$100.00 Confirmation 2024 fee due November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023

Tuitions and Fees can be paid in installments. Please bring (minimally) a deposit of 50% of the tuition per student toward the full tuition at the time of registration. Payment of Faith Formation tuition and/or Sacrament Classes fees can be made by personal check, money order or cash. If your family is experiencing financial difficulties currently, please speak with the Coordinator of Faith Formation. Arrangements can be made and please register your child (ren) – **your child's** formal Faith Formation is important!

Registration will be in the Faith Formation office. The Faith Formation office is typically staffed on Saturdays, Mondays, and Tuesdays. Please call-in advance to make sure the office is open. If the above times are not convenient, please call 1-708-484-7951 ext. 5 or email [spxre@sbcglobal.net](mailto:spxre@sbcglobal.net) and make an appointment to register your child (ren). **ALL STUDENTS SHOULD BE REGISTERED BY SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2021.** Classes begin on Saturday, October 2, 2021 and Tuesday, October 5, 2021.

If you are registering a new student, please bring his/her birth AND Baptismal certificates, completed registration form, release/permission form, the signed policy sheet, photo permission slip, Parish Registration Form, and any other Sacrament certificates (if available). These will be photocopied for the child's permanent file.

If you are re-registering a student, please bring the completed registration form, release/permission form, the signed policy sheet, photo permission slip, Parish Registration Form, and other Sacrament certificates (if available).

Please read the Faith Formation Policies and Guidelines carefully before signing and returning the registration forms and the signed policy sheet.

I encourage you to avoid the lines by registering your child (ren) early. All registrations are taken on a first come, first served basis. Early registration is important, especially if you have any special requests. After September 1, I cannot guarantee that I will be able to honor special requests.

Policies and Guidelines  
2021-2022

The Faith Formation Classes for Grades Kindergarten through Grade 5 will meet on Saturday mornings, starting October 2, 2021 from 9:00am until 10:30am.

The Faith Formation Classes for Grades 6, 7 and 8 will meet on Tuesday evenings starting October 5, 2021 from 7:00pm until 8:30pm.

The Faith Formation Classes are for students in Kindergarten through Grade 8. High School students preparing for Confirmation will attend Faith Formation classes on Tuesday evenings. Kindergarten students must have reached their fifth birthday on/before September 1, 2021.

St. Pius X Parish Faith Formation Classes is operated under the auspices of the Catholic Bishop of Chicago, a corporation sole, in the Archdiocese of Chicago.

St. Pius X Parish Faith Formation Classes admits students of any sex, race, color, or national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, Classes, and activities generally accorded are made available to students in this Faith Formation Classes.

St. Pius X Parish Faith Formation Classes does not discriminate based on sex, race, color, or national and ethnic origin in administration of its policies, supplementary Classes, or any other Classes-based function.

It is expected that each family become actively involved in St. Pius X Faith Formation Classes and Parish to model a living, conscious and active Christian faith and to reinforce the values and attitudes for living that faith. It is assumed that families will worship with the community of St. Pius X on a regular basis and there are many ways for family members to be involved in the life of our parish, by volunteering for the various ministries, activities and committees, and financial support of the parish through the weekly and special collections is expected. Each child receives a box of envelopes at their first session. It is encouraged that the children use the envelopes when they attend mass. A financial gift is recommended, and it is asked that the child consider doing a good deed during the week and acknowledging that deed on the envelope. The family and their children also agree to act in accordance with these values and attitudes. Failure of a family member to act in a truly Christian manner or cooperate fully with St. Pius X Parish may lead to the removal or non-registration of the family member attending the Faith Formation Classes. If you are NOT a registered family, please fill out the Parish Registration Form included in the packet.

The Catechists, Aides, and Parents, who are the primary educators of children, form a team. As we hand on our Roman Catholic traditions, we believe that we are giving them a valuable tool to interpret life, and that we are sharing with them the Good News that we have found in faith. Parents, first and foremost, pass on the faith to the children, we as catechists help the children to understand our faith. As the parish catechetical staff, we have outlined the following policies to assure a harmonious, effective, and enjoyable Faith Formation year together.

ENROLLMENT: St. Pius X's Faith Formation Classes is generally accorded or made available to students whose families are registered in the parish. Exceptions to this general policy will be reviewed on an individual basis by the Pastor and Coordinator of Faith Formation. In all cases, the availability of the Classes to families outside of the parish will be made only

when the needs of St. Pius X Parish have been determined to have been adequately met.

Policy on admissions:

Priority:

1. Children of parishioners
  - A. children from families with children already enrolled
  - B. children now reaching school age
  - C. children transferring from a parish school
  - D. children from families newly moved into the parish
  
2. Children of non-parishioners
  - A. children from families with children already enrolled
  - B. children now reaching school age
  - C. children transferring from a parish school
  - D. other children seeking to enroll

REGISTRATION: Registration for the Faith Formation Classes begins now. Registrations are taken on a first come, first served basis. Registrations can be made in person. Minimally, a deposit toward the full cost of tuition is expected at the time of registration.

TUITION/SACRAMENT CLASSES FEE PAYMENTS: Tuition and Sacrament Classes fees can be paid in regular payments from now until March 2022. It is expected that each family enrolled in the St. Pius X Faith Formation Classes pay the required tuition for the Classes as well as the required Sacrament fees. If unforeseen financial difficulties arise during the year, please contact the Coordinator of Faith Formation immediately. No child will be denied Faith Formation due to the financial circumstances of the family. (We must be made aware of the special circumstances to insure enrollment for the following year.) Payment of Faith Formation tuition and/or Sacrament Classes fees can be made by personal check, money order or cash.

If personal checks are returned NSF twice during any one school year, payment will be accepted only by cash or money order, thereafter. If we, the parish, are charged bank fees for the NSF check, reimbursement of these fees is required, also.

Faith Formation tuition and fees for the 2021-2022 school year will be:

\$140.00 for each student registered of registered families of St. Pius X

\$200.00 for each student of non-registered families.

\$50.00 First Communion 2022 fee due March 1, 2022

\$100.00 Confirmation 2024 fee due November 1, 2023

Tuitions and Fees can be paid in installments. Please bring (minimally) a deposit of 50% of the tuition per student toward the full tuition at the time of registration. If your family is experiencing financial difficulties currently, please speak with the Coordinator of Faith Formation. Arrangements can be made and please register your child (ren) – **your child's formal** Faith Formation is important!

Registration will be in the Faith Formation office. The Faith Formation office is typically staffed on Saturdays, Mondays, and Tuesdays. Please call-in advance to make sure the office is open. If the above times are not convenient, please call 1-708-484-7951 ext. 5 or email [spxre@sbcglobal.net](mailto:spxre@sbcglobal.net) and make an appointment to register your child (ren). **ALL STUDENTS SHOULD BE REGISTERED BY SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, 2021.** Classes begin on Saturday, October 2, 2021 and Tuesday, October 5, 2021.

All tuition must be paid in full no later than March 1, 2022.

First Communion 2022 Fee due by March 1, 2022.

Confirmation 2024 Fee due by November 4, 2023.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP: When dropping off and picking up your child (ren), please park in the lot on Grove Avenue. Grove Avenue will not be blocked by safety cones. All students will enter and exit through the Church narthex. The Grove Avenue doors are for emergency use only. Parents may drop off / pick up children on the south side of 43<sup>rd</sup> Street between Grove Ave and Oak Park Ave. Students need to cross in the crosswalks either on Grove Ave or Oak Park Ave., NOT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE STREET. During the brief period prior to the beginning of class, we ask that students stay out of the courtyard and grassy areas which can be muddy and/or covered with snow. Students should wait in the narthex until the Catechists, Aides, or Office Support escort the students to their classrooms. In cold or rainy weather, please see that your child arrives no earlier than 8:50am or 6:50pm, as children will not be admitted to the classrooms before class. There is no adult supervision outside of the building before or after classes. Adults do wait a reasonable length of time for parents to pick up their child (ren) after class. If an adult does not pick up a child, the child will return the Faith Formation Office and wait for an adult to pick him/her up.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR/DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES: The same rules that govern our children's daytime classes also govern their Faith Formation classes. Faith Formation is school. It would be unfair to those who take instruction seriously if there were not guidelines to keep all classrooms well ordered. We are confident that our students can show courtesy, respect, and attention during Faith Formation classes.

If a student is disruptive, the catechist will address the issue, if the student does not cooperate, the student will then be sent to the Coordinator of Faith Formation. If this becomes a pattern, the parent will be called to make an appointment to speak with the Coordinator of Faith Formation and the catechist. If the disruptive behavior continues it may become necessary for the Coordinator of Faith Formation to remove the child from the Classes. The Coordinator of Faith Formation will provide alternative approaches of Faith Formation to the parent. At times, a "Behavior Contract" must be agreed upon and signed by parent, student, and Coordinator of Faith Formation as a requirement for admission to the Classes.

Please note that if there is any destruction of property, the offending child (ren)'s parent(s) will be called, and it will be the family's responsibility to make restitution.

We reserve the right to inspect all desks or other parish supplied enclosures. In addition, we reserve the right to inspect a participant's personal property when there is reasonable belief that the individual is violating the rules, regulations, and policies of St. Pius X Faith Formation Classes.

Portable electronic devices, toys, candy, gum, etc. are not to be brought to class. If these things are brought to class, they can be taken away and can be picked up by THE PARENT. These items will be kept in the Faith Formation office.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

Fire Drills will be conducted during the school year.

Snow days: If Faith Formation classes must be canceled because of snow/ice storms, you will be notified by phone, as soon as possible after the decision has been made. Your child's catechist or the Coordinator of Faith Formation will contact you.

Tornado weather: If there is a tornado warning in effect, students will not be dismissed to walk home, if a parent or other adult is present to take the child (ren) home, the parent/adult assumes the responsibility of seeing the child (ren) home safely.

We must have the Emergency Information on hand: an emergency number - someone other than the parent or some way to contact a parent e.g., cell phone. Please see that this information is current with the office. Please notify the office immediately of a change in phone number, address, or emergency contact person.

ABSENTEE CODE: Please make sure that your child (ren) attends each Faith Formation Class and arrives on time and ready to begin class immediately. Since we meet a minimum of Twenty-seven (27) times and there is so much material to be explored and learned, regular attendance is a requirement. Only four (4) absences will be allowed, and all work covered during the absence is expected to be made up. If absenteeism is noted to be a problem, a notice may be sent to the parent indicating that a conference will be necessary with the parent, catechist, child, and Coordinator of Faith Formation. Excessive absenteeism may result in delay of the receiving of a sacrament. Therefore, please save all absences for illness or unforeseen emergencies. If your child must be absent, please call the Faith Formation Office (708-484-7951 ext. 5) or email at [spxre@sbcglobal.net](mailto:spxre@sbcglobal.net) before the start time on the day of class. Students will be listed as an **"UNEXCUSED ABSENCE"** if a parent fails to call in the absence. Please do not call the Parish Office (Rectory).

TARDINESS: Any student who arrives after the scheduled start time is to enter through the Church Narthex and go to the Faith Formation Table for a tardy slip.

EARLY DISMISSAL: Our limited schedule means that we must make the most of every minute of class time. We ask your cooperation in making doctor/dentist appointments on Saturday mornings or Tuesday evenings. If for some reason your child (ren) needs to be dismissed before class time ends, the Coordinator of Faith Formation and Catechist must be notified in writing and a parent/guardian must come to the Faith Formation Office (at the specified time of dismissal) and sign an early dismissal slip. No child will be allowed to leave the building until a parent/guardian signs the dismissal slip. This is to ensure the safety and well-being of our students.

HOMEWORK: Faith Formation homework is important! Please see that your child completes homework assignments and SEE THAT YOUR CHILD BRINGS BOTH COMPLETED ASSIGNMENTS, FOLDER, TEXTBOOK and ACTIVITY BOOK to class. (Textbooks are sent home at the discretion of the individual catechist. Homework may not be assigned after each class. Homework assignments are given at the discretion of the individual catechist.) Please encourage your child to share the lessons with you. At times, homework assignments will require a parent/guardian's signature.

MEDICATION: Except in extraordinary circumstances which must be approved by the Coordinator of Faith Formation, the Faith Formation personnel will not maintain, supervise the taking of, or administer any type of medication.

LITURGICAL EXPERIENCES: It is our assumption that the children enrolled in our Faith Formation Classes attend Mass on a regular basis. Regular Mass attendance is important, as being a part of the worshipping community helps the student to see how religion and faith are part of daily life. The students do participate in prayer services on a regular basis as a part of the Faith Formation Classes. This is not a substitute for or in place of regular weekend Mass attendance.

SACRAMENTAL CLASSES POLICY: Our Faith Formation Classes for students attending public school is, minimally, eight (8) years. Each year is unique and important and SHOULD NOT BE SKIPPED. Any student wishing to receive a sacrament (e.g., Baptism, First

Eucharist, First Reconciliation, Confirmation), MUST be enrolled and ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE in a Faith Formation Classes for two consecutive years prior to the reception of First Holy Communion and two consecutive years prior to the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation.

This means a child must have attended both first and second grade Faith Formation before the reception of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the spring of second grade.

For the reception of Confirmation, the student must have attended, minimally, seventh and eighth grades of Faith Formation and taken an active role in the preparation for Confirmation.

PARENTAL ACCESS TO CHILD/RECORDS: The St. Pius X Parish Faith Formation Classes abides by the provisions of the Buckley Amendment. Divorced/Separated parents must file a COURT CERTIFIED COPY OF THE CUSTODY section of the divorce decree or separation agreement with the Faith Formation Office. This will become a part of your child's permanent record. If at any time, the custody of the child changes, an amended copy must be filed with the office. Briefly, the Buckley Amendment provides that BOTH parents have access to the child's records, though physical access to the child is determined by the court decree.

CALENDAR: A calendar is included with the registration packet and is given at the beginning of each school year with class dates, important parent meetings, etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST: Each student will be required to bring school supplies to the first day of class. Each Catechist requires different supplies. A list will be announced later.

Statements in this handbook are subject to amendment with or without notice. The Faith Formation Classes will attempt to keep you informed of all changes as soon as practical; however, some changes might be made immediately due to unforeseen circumstances.
